		The training programme has been started in collaboration with NIIT, Chennai. The Ist batch commenced in October 2001 completed in January 2002. 10 candidates have completed the course. The 2 nd Batch consisting of 5 trainees commenced in February 2002.
		The out put of the programme enabled the trainees to have access to computer programme basics., It also supplements various areas like the memory, function and academic and logic concept formation of the visually impaired. The Jaws 2000 program through computer is attractive and more interesting through conventional methods with the help of Voice Synthesizer. It also improves the trainees tolerance and attitude to learn more.
		The feed back of the training programme gives us that the trainees are slow in understanding to Jaws accent (the American version of English). They are also slow in operating the keyboard system. These aspects are taken care by our Committee and plan to introduce simultaneously English language teaching and typing for the trainees. We also wish to extend the training facility to other disabled needy trainees.
